Delegates' own presentations (workshops, lectures etc.) may count as a work-exchange. For example, a presenter who is giving a workshop in an A1 slot may attend a workshop in A2. Please circle the presentations you yourself are giving.

Please write your enrolment number and name on each sheet and return them by post or by fax to reach us no later than 30th July. Forms will be processed in enrolment number order. Forms arriving after 30th July will be processed in the order in which they arrive. We cannot accept resposibility for forms lost in the post.

When registering on the first day of the Congress, Monday 16th August, you will be given a list of your allocated workshops and work-exchanges. Should you change your mind you can do so provided there is space available in the workshop you wish to change to. Please see the programme for details.

We regret that the timetable and workshops may change without warning (four workshops were cancelled before the programme went to print). We will try to give as much notice as possible. If a workshop you have chosen is cancelled there will be alternatives available. Changes to the programme before the start of the Congress will be announced on www.atcongress.net.
